What is FreeBSD?

- Record breaking performance (ftp cdrom).
- Hotmail, Yahoo.
- Cisco Ironport, Isilon, Citri: NetApp.
- Apple MacOS X, iOS
- Illumos.
- Debian kFreeBSD.





FreeBSD: a free Operating System

- Based on BSD 4.4 lite: there is a design!
- Berkeley license: GPL not welcome.
- VM, UFSv2, jails, malloc, well known and documented.
- Rock Stable Performance
- Optional but stable: ZFS and Dtrace.

You have used it!



FreeBSD ports: some history

- 24,011 ports available.
- cd
 - /usr/ports/editors/openoffice-3
- make install
- That's it!
- Related to pkgsrc, Gentoo,
 Debian, Darwin ports.



What about OpenOffice.org?

- Huge: 7'633 000 LOC
 June(2011)
- C++ (60%), HTML (18%), XML (8.5%), Java (6%)
- Criticized by the FSF: extensions and Java.
- Criticized by Novell and others for JCA.
- Not really a threat for MS?





- Non restrictive licensing.
- Credible Governance.

Can Apache do for the Office what FreeBSD has done for Apple?



Dependencies and Packaging concerns

- Transition from internal version in OOo to system versions in the port.
- Kill the GNU: not as difficult as it seemed?.
- Get the internal versions updated even when we don't use them.



Specifics: getting rid of GNU dependencies

- Things that had to be removed.
- Things that had to be replaced:
- Things that had to be updated.

 Internal code changes for the FreeBSD port.



Copyleft stuff that was removed (cleaned?).

- Glibc (including regex derivative).
- Gettext
- Libsrvg, libcroco, libgsf, gdkpixbug
 - Berkeleydb
 - Mysql, libwpd, Pentaho



Copyleft code that was replaced

- Lpsolve (Coin-OR)
- Libneon (serf)
- Liberation Fonts (ChromeOS)
- SVG stuff.(alg@)
- Lcc cpp (ucpp) actually noncommercial license.



Changes required for FreeBSD

- More that 28 issues known (maho@)
- bash has performance issues. checkbashisms
- Gnucopy -ru, not portable.
- Gnutar
- Mktemp
- Gnu patch (still working on this)



If it ain't broken don't fix it ... oops it's broken!

- System libraries can break the build.
- Old libraries have bugs
- New libraries can have ABI changes.
- Usually newer libraries build on more compilers/OS.

You know easily when you broke something.



Other Apache Projects

- Updated to stable but compatible versions:
- Apache Tomcat 5.5.35
- Apache commons (log langhttpclient -codec)
- Lucene 2.9.4
- Serf brought APR.

Some day: beanshell, pdfbox ?



Updates based on the FreeBSD port

- Python 2.7.3
- Boost 1.48
- Expat 2.1.0
- Jpeg 8d
- Vigra 1.6.0
- Mdds 0.3.1

Still missing (tough) icu and STLPort.



Future Perspectives

- FreeBSD will replace all the GNU toolchain with CLANG. New Xcode will need this as well.
- BSD and Solaris buildbots would be good.

We are building a reputation of stability and performance. Features are not a priority.



Some Lessons

- There is a growing tendency for non-copyleft code.
 Companies pay salaries.
- It is possible to contribute to your favorite coding project without being the best coder but having a strategy.

Updating the API is a good idea before merging new code.
