- 0.8 was recommended for production
- 0.6 was used in production
- 1.0 communicates "you can use this now"
- the glitch
- the maginficent fixup

### The Inventor Leaves

- first silently, stops contributing
- helps guiding a few improvements
- after two years proper, publicly announces departure of the project
- is a bit of a dick about it

- be in charge of your message
- Even a [B][D][FL] can turn against you make sure he isn't your most public channel.

#### The Users

- two flagship users leave, blog about it
- nothing major, but creates the perception of:
- "CouchDB is dead"
- While many people happily keep using it

- Technical change happens
- Users move on
- Learn from failure
- Failure helps to define project's technical boundaries

## Meanwhile at the Legion of Doom in the Database World

- NoSQL Happens
- MongoDB "wins" NoSQL
- Everybody else jumps onto BigData
- Some folks just keep innovating (Cassandra)
- Postgres ships JSON types
- The world keeps embracing JSON
- JS becomes a viable embedded scripting language
- ISO SQL starts to investigate NoSQL, SQL/JSON for SQL 2015
